Presentation from PBIS teams

- Elem Team: Use of the STARR (Stop, Think, Act, Respectfully and Responsibly) model for students. Monthly assemblies, building and classroom matrix of behaviors. Panther Prides are given for positives. The goal is to have 4 (or more) positives per 1 negative. Working on parental involvement with inviting parents to attend the assemblies.
- 2. MS Team: PRIDE (Preperation, Responsibility, Integrity, Determination and Effort) model.

 Assemblies happen every 6 weeks focusing on one of the PRIDE letters. Each grade level plans one of the assemblies that focuses on one of those areas. PRIDE model students are chosen at each assembly (I per grade) that have shown those great behaviors during the past 6 weeks, and their parents surprise them at the assembly. 5th and 6th grade use paper Panther Prides and 7th and 8th grade use online positive tickets.
